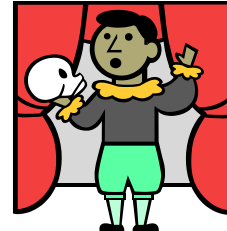
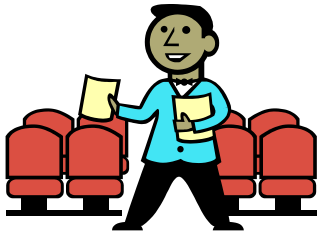

Age: 9-13

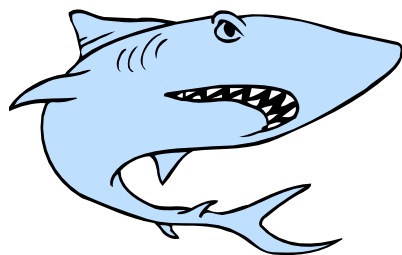
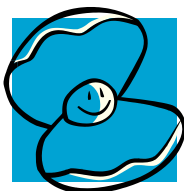
