2. Critical Friends Visit: The "Critical Friends" Assessment Team will spend November 2-5, 2004 with District 41 stakeholders to gain their perspective on our systems and processes. This visit is an opportunity for District 41 to gather baseline data on how we are doing around our core systems and processes (leadership, strategic planning, strategic results, student and stakeholder focus, human resources, process management and process results.)By establishing a baseline, the District will be able to measure improvement in the future. Members of the "Critical Friends" team have been trained by the Consortium for Educational Change (CEC) and have been through this process themselves. During this meeting, assessment team members conducted one-on-one interviews with board members to gather data to assess the effectiveness of the Central Services Office at the District level.
