- * Range of options
- * Aggressive behavior seems to address bullying – broad definition
- * Handbook language is easy to read and understand
- * Clarifying statement at bottom of matrix

- * Reader-friendly
- * Sanction code: good clarity
- * No sanctions left out
- * Most sanctions are thorough & fair
- * Not many prohibited actions left off the list

- * Weapons – everything not black and white. Have to listen to find out what happened – range good
- * Aggressive - good
- * Tobacco – good
- * Possession – good
- * Alcohol, drugs – good
- * Theft – good
- * Insubordination – good
- * Tardiness – good

DELTA

- * No In- School Suspensions listed
- * Cyber bullying not addressed
- * New age sexual harassment needs to be addressed - “sexting”
- * Police contact isn’t automatic for weapons
- * Intent considered more clearly in weapons
- * Mention by-standers in bullying
- * Tobacco – more options in range (counseling, parent conference, etc.)
- * Matrix language needs to match

- * Add bullying
- * Alphabetize prohibited actions
- * Clarification of terminology - project visa
- * Community Service/Police Partnership -add a sanction
- * Gang activity – list what this includes -lesser offenses – not 5 days suspension
- * Distribution of materials-list examples
- * Tech/Communic Devices/Inc. of Privacy – Group as one – add “sexting” & cyberbullying
- * Bold all after Theft

- * Determined to be very serious needs to be more than 1 day
- * Can parents (have communications) be aware of the discipline? Follow up with results
- * tobacco – extended circumstance (Did you pick up a box of matches from dinner?)
- * Bombs, explosives & terrorists – follow thru on all minimums

PLUS

- * **The range of recommended sanctions is necessary due to the variety of situations that occur**
- * **The notification at the bottom**

DELTA

- * **Pg. 3 inconsistent with pg. 4 of board Policy – regarding weapons**
- * **Review handbook & policies with students in class during the first week of school – or during orientation**
- * **Broaden the definition of harassment to include technology (ie. text message, instant message, etc.)**
- * **Tobacco consequences should be equal to alcohol & drugs – both are illegal**
- * **It should be stated in the handbook that consequences may vary based on the child's age and the intent**
- * **Tardiness – maximum does not make sense – 14 should be maximum – not 9**

- * **Dress code – include communication with parent (4) as minimum**
- * **Fire, bombs, explosives – include #14 in maximum. Also, terrorist-type activities**
- * **Conference with parent to include phone or in person.**
- * **Parent conference should be include in all minimum sanctions**
- * **Violation of law needs to be automatic #14**
